One situation experienced this month was with a patient that had experience with NA and sponsorship and asked the panel if they would sponsor him or could he work the steps on his own while in treatment. H&I Sub-Comm. had several suggestions.

Peninsula Adult: The meetings usually start at 6:30pm and lasts to 7:30pm. (**Thursday Meeting**) Adam L. gave a verbal report for Steve H. Things are going well. (**Monday Meeting**) Amanda B., panel leader, (Absent). This meeting starts around 6:30pm and always lasts an hour. No report for this facility.
