6 out of 10 panel chairs were present or represented this month. The voting body was 12.

Approval of the Minutes: A motion was made by Randy and was seconded by Mickey to approve the minutes with no change. Passed 12-0-0. Thereafter the panel leaders presented their monthly reports.

Centerpointe: Randy gave a verbal report. This meeting is twice a month on every other Saturday and starts at 8:30pm to 9:30pm. This facility is averaging six panelist and twenty patients. He said that all is well. Randy was unable to attend once this month but he was represented. They are holding meetings outside.

Centerpointe Detox: Walker, panel leader, was present. This meeting meets every Wednesday night at 8:00 PM. Walker apologizes for his resent absents. He said that four females are coming as panelist. Centerpointe is increasing bed space. He said everything is going well. They are seeing some patients at meetings.

Peninsula Adolescent: Keith B., panel leader, was absent. The panel is meeting Thursdays at 6:30 pm.

Peninsula Adult: The meetings start at 6:30pm and lasts to 7:30pm. **(Thursday Meeting)** Joy K., panel leader, gave verbal report. Average number of three panel members, two female attending each week with ten to twelve patients. Joy K. attended four out of four times. She said that all is well. **(Monday Meeting)** Bill G., panel leader, gave a verbal report. Bill was able to attend four out four times. There has been an average of four panel members. Bill said that detox patient attendance varies but the participation is good.

Gateway: Anthony B., panel leader, was present. This panel continues to meet on Tuesdays at 7:00pm. The facility continues to be all male, average age 15-17. This facility has about seven clients with three or four panel members. The patients are coming up with their own topic and readings to discuss. Patients are asking questions.

KCSD: Ethan W., panel leader, was absent with representation. David gave a verbal report. This panel meets Wednesday at 6:00pm for 60 minutes. The average number of panelist is 3. The meeting went in every time this month. He said that all is well. They are having two meetings now. They request more attendance. The women's Basic Text donations have not been delivered because they are hard bound copies. The jail requires the books to be soft bound.
